UNDERGRADUATES - December 15th
GRADUATE STUDENTS - March 15th

REQUIREMENTS

- An undergraduate or graduate student who is a permanent U.S. resident
- A minimum GPA of 3.3
- Your resume (maximum of two pages)
- A brief statement of why you are interested in a career in healthcare (no more than one page)
- One ISE faculty recommendation
